**IMPORTANT NOTES**

- A final grade of a **B** or better is required for each course.
- Students must maintain a 3.00 or higher for both “Term GPA” and “Cumulative GPA”.

Please note any course in the plan of study may require mandatory, synchronous virtual sessions.</li> <li>The mandatory online clinical orientation is a synchronous, one-night information session. This is not a course for credit.</li> <li>Nurse Practitioner students are required to take NURS550 – Advanced Health Assessment and Diagnostic Reasoning, the spring quarter immediately preceding the first clinical-based course and after the completion of the track specific pharmacology course.</li> <li>Clinical courses require both clinical and didactic coursework. Both clinical and didactic coursework must be successfully completed to earn a passing grade in the course.</li> </ul>
