- A final grade of a **B** or better is required for each course
- Students must maintain a 3.00 or better for your final "Term GPA" and "Cumulative GPA".
- Financial Aid/Student Loans graduate students who utilize student loans must maintain a minimum enrollment of <u>4.5</u> credits per Quarter or proceed with the two courses per quarter plan of study.
- NURS 632 runs over two quarters (20 weeks). Students who will be eligible to start the practicum preparation process approximately 6 months prior to the start of the course.
- IPS 617 Required three (3) day OCI in Philadelphia to be completed with course enrollment.
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- The Graduate College policy requires students to complete the program within **five** years of their first enrollment term.
